Essendon Fields Airport provides facilities and services for international and domestic corporate aircraft, aircraft maintenance, air freight, aircraft charter, passenger airlines and emergency air service providers. Combined, these operators undertake more than 50,000 annual aircraft movements. Since 2001, the airport has undertaken numerous upgrades and is now one of the leading General Aviation and Corporate Jet Airports in Australia. Passengers can conveniently take off to regional destinations with commercial airlines operating from the airport.

At Essendon Fields, we're committed to protecting our local environment today, for a sustainable tomorrow. This includes ensuring we minimise the impact of our daily operations, whilst creating clean, green spaces for our local community to enjoy.

Essendon Fields pocket parks, walking trails and outdoor spaces attract joggers, cyclists and walkers from across the local area. Urban regeneration plans at Essendon Fields focus on initiatives aimed at limiting our environmental impact.

New developments from 2014 onwards have included rainwater harvesting tanks, and over 335,000 litres of water are collected from hangar rooves and redistributed to our onsite tree farm, which is cultivating 15,000 trees for planting around the precinct. We also offset 100% of carbon emissions from our airfield lighting, and have commenced the installation of hundreds of solar panels, producing clean energy that feeds back into our embedded network to power the precinct.

The success of this approach is evident, with our landscapers, Green by Nature, taking out the 2018 Victorian Best Commercial Landscape Award, and Essendon Fields being crowned Australia's Best Urban Renewal Project 2020 by the UDIA.



PUBLIC TRANSPORT



The Route 477 bus route runs from Broadmeadows to Moonee Ponds and connects Essendon Fields to Essendon Train Station (trips avg. 15 mins).

Services operate 7 days a week, departing every 20 minutes during peak hour.

Tram service 59 is a short walk from EF Stop 56 (Airport West), located on Matthews Ave/ Earl Street departs every 8 minutes.
