New Business

Fly Pelican conducted closed charter during August and September between EFA & Mt Hotham.

70sqm of concrete pavement replacement on Southern Apron adjacent H85.

Hangar 85 Concrete Apron Repairs, Hangar 102 Drain Edge Repairs, Runway 17/35 Drain Cover Repairs and Taxiway C Drain Edge Repairs

\$250k survey, drain clearing and initial repairs. Identified program of works

AEP Activation:

12 July 2023 - Full Emergency declared after Air Ambulance King Air VH-VAE advised ATC a landing gear failure indicator in the cockpit at 12:33am. Aircraft landed without incident at 1:08am. Inspector Pat McKinnon from the State Emergency & SupportCommand noted "Access to airside, internal and inter-agency comms were excellent, roles were clear and command was established and exercised well".

• AEP Exercise: November

• Fire season: 2 helicopters – Skycrane & night fire fighting capability

7. Development Update (EAPL)

BE provided a detailed update of planned new development across the airport which included the civil works underway in the Hart Precinct to facilitate the development of a future 20,000m2 warehouse which will develop modular buildings.

Development of 274 Lionel Street has also commenced with a new vehicle dealership to be constructed for Audi on Wirraway Road in the new year.

8. EF Master Plan (Planning Matters)

Extension of time to lodge the Masterplan with the Department of Infrastructure has been approved. The Master Plan will now be lodged by January 2025. EAPL will likely go out to public consultation in August 2024.

BE noted that EAPL has undertaken a review of the 2006 Heritage Management Plan.
